This report looks at how organisations collect information about you.



It looks at reasons why **demographic data** can be helpful and why it can cause problems.

Why do organisations collect your information?



To understand who uses their services and make sure everyone is treated fairly.



To improve services so they work better for different people.

Does it matter what data is collected?



Data Collection improves services. People should know how their information is used.



Some data is **confidential**. It is important to know why it is collected.

What do young people want?



A clear and simple way of collecting data.



To feel respected and not judged.



More choice about sharing their information.

How young people would improve data collection?



Make forms easy to understand.



Explain why the data is needed.



Give people the option to say no.

What support workers want?



Data should be used fairly. There should be more training about **data collection.**



Listen to people's concerns about **data** collection.
